SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **RULES:** The race will be governed by the current 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) except as modified by this Notice of Race and/or the Sailing Instructions.

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- 2.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the door of the RBYC Race Committee Room.
- 2.2 Any changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted by 1100 on race day.
- 2.3 The Race Committee may provide VHF radio broadcasts on VHF channel 78.

3. RACE SCHEDULE

- 3.1 Each class will have one race. First Start is **1300**.
- 3.2 **Spinnaker Class “A” flag, Non-Spinnaker “B” Flag**
- 3.3 The starting times and order for the classes is intended to be:

1254 - multiple horns, Attention:

1255 Spinnaker Class-warning, Flag “A”

1300 Spinnaker Class - **Start**

1305 Non-Spinnaker Class - **Start**

4. COURSES AND MARKS

- 4.1 The courses will use the marks in front of Redondo Beach shown on the current KHYC mark guide found online at www.khyc.org
- 4.2 The race committee will designate the course to be sailed by displaying the corresponding course number, **OR by VHF RADIO**, no later than the Preparatory Signal.
- 4.3 The courses are shown on a list of courses at the end of these instructions.
- 4.4 **Round all marks to port.**

5. THE START

- 5.1 The starting line will be between an orange flag on the race committee boat and the “S” spar.
- 5.2 The starting line is restricted unless starting.
- 5.3 The starts of the races will be conducted according to RRS 26.
- 5.4 All competing vessels must check in with the committee boat prior to **1250**.
- 5.5 Boats not in their starting sequence shall avoid boats that are starting.
- 5.6 The Race Committee may hail OCS boats on channel 78. Failure of the Race Committee to hail, or a boat to hear its hail, or the order of the hails, is not grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).

6. THE FINISH

- 6.1 The Finish Line is between an orange flag on the race committee boat and the Red Nun Buoy located at the harbor entrance. **“W”** (white channel buoy) is a mark of the course.
- 6.2 The Finish Line is restricted, unless finishing.

7. PENALTY The first two sentences of RRS 44.1 are modified to: A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 while racing.

8. TIME LIMIT A boat failing to finish by 1600 will be scored “DNF” by the Race Committee. This changes RRS 35 and A4.1.

9. PROTESTS

- 9.1 Boats intending to protest must fly a red flag upon finishing and notify the Race Committee While it is on station.
- 9.2 Protests shall be written on forms available at the club and delivered to the Race Chairman or PRO within 45 minutes after the race committee boat docks.

10. SCORING

- 10.1 RLC ratings depending on selected course, time on time, using the low point system.

11. SAFETY

- 11.1 A boat that retires must notify the Race Committee as soon as possible, on vhf Ch-78, or 310-806-2992.

12. Disclaimer of Liability – Competitors participate in the race entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race.
